Extra point for dress and extra point for firestart under 30 seconds also bring your own firestart kit

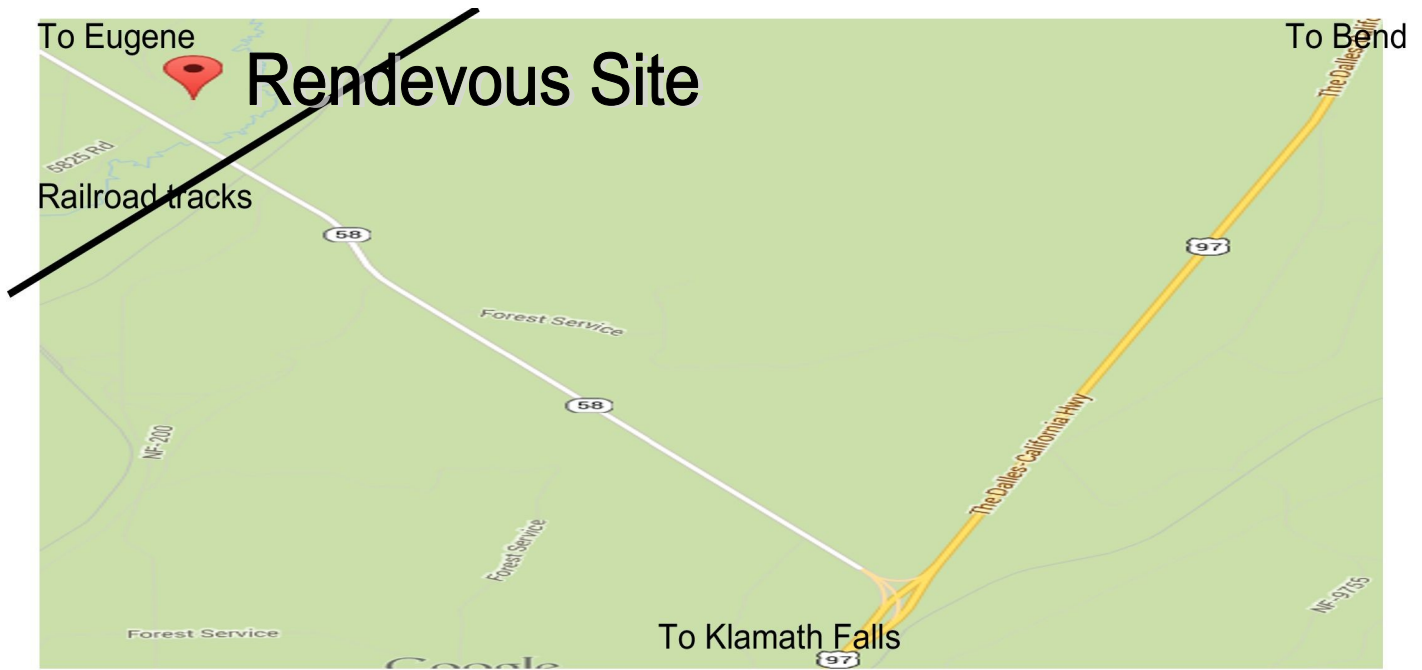
Please be responsible for your animals, by keeping them leashed and cleaning up after them
